

Tree Warden Report

My update for the last period is that I've visited Coltsfoot, Attleton and Genesis Greens over the last few weeks.

I haven't used the app because I visit the greens on different days, but the information and photos or any issues have all been reported by email to the Clerk.

I haven't been to Moor Green because I can't work out where it is.

The What3Words location appears to be in Mike Lavelle's back garden so I'm guessing that's not right.

I also accompanied Cliff from Acacia Tree Services for his annual survey - three fascinating hours - and learnt a lot about what he's looking for on his reviews.

Some key points from the review are that:

- There are lots of mature trees in the village now that weren't on his list when he started the surveys because they were so small then. He thinks he should add them to the list.
- Some of the trees that he does review have lost their silver tags - magpies or squirrels apparently - so will have to be refixed.
- I told him that we have a team of volunteers so he said he will add a Volunteer column to his report identifying tasks that we can do without needing to pay someone.
- A 'blue fir' tree (sorry that I can't be more accurate with the description) has been planted at the front of the church. Cliff noted that this would be enormous in a few years and expressed concern that it had been planted in the wrong place - we're going to regret it being there
