You will receive a membership number to be quoted when making a booking plus a four-digit code for the access padlocks on the two court gates. These will be changed later in May.

Booking system

Please ensure you follow the system and book through the village Parish Council website by following the link to our Google Calendar. Ideally booking should be made at least a day in advance to allow the diary is updated over night, alternatively you can take a chance that one court will be free. (Although priority given to those who have booked)

1. Play will be for fully paid up members with access to the courts through the existing lock and code system. A new code will be issued on 15th May and issued on payment of your annual subscription.
2. Courts can be booked up to one week in advance utilizing a Google diary link from the village Parish Council website. There is an email booking link to the club. Please quote your membership ID and description of game (Singles, Doubles or Family) and time requested.
3. Please Access the courts via the Village Hall track to minimize contact with school staff and pupils and to keep the school car park access free
4. Court bookings will run on a 90-minute cycle starting at 8.00 am.
